## MANAGING WASTE AT EVENTS

Vermont law requires that producers/hosts of large and small events must make sure that event staff, volunteers, attendees, and vendors understand and adhere to recycling and waste management requirements.

Typical materials generated at events are listed below. #### Accepted Recyclable Materials \*Please NO food in Recycle Bins – EMPTY Containers ONLY\*

#### Paper

White & Colored Newspapers Magazines Softcover books Mail Paper bags Wrapping paper

## Glass Containers

All glass bottles & jars

#### Metal

Cans Aluminum trays & foil (& lids) Aerosol cans (empty)

#### Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard (no food) Boxboard (cereal & cracker boxes) Frozen food boxes (only if it rips)

#### Plastic #1-7 (PETE & HDPE)

Milk jug Soda, juice & water bottles Plastic clamshell containers NO film/wrap/bags NO Styrofoam

#### **NOT Accepted Materials for Recycling**

Mirror glass, light bulbs, glass dishes, ceramics, foam packaging, Styrofoam, juice/drink/wine/milk/cream/half&half cartons, hot beverage cups, plastic bags, hazardous materials (fuels, cleaners, etc.)

#### Food scraps should be separated from trash and recycling for composting.
