April 5, 2023

Kristen made a motion to accept the minutes as written, Adam seconded, and all were in favor.

Directors Report: \$300 VT Lib Summer Grant awarded to the library. Kristine and Lisa attended the VLA Conference in order to better determine future grant eligibility as well as streamlining the process through needs assessments and started the application process for a couple upcoming grants.

Old Business: Fundraising - BINGO April 30th at 2pm \$10 per sheet of games, \$30 for a family of 4 (2 full sheets, 2 kid sheets). The "Sap Cover" raffle has brought in \$510 so far.

New Business: After discussing the pros and cons of the library funds remaining in the M&T Bank CD verses moving them into an insured investment account through Community Bank, Wendy made a motion to have Almira transfer those funds into the higher interest account. Adam seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Tanya had the idea of people bringing plants to the library to swap as an ongoing event to attract new people to the library. She is going to look into logistics and what a program like this would look like, how to start it and what to call it.
