**MINUTES OF August 31, 2022**

Dana called meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

Brad Lackey nominated Dana Dix for chair of the commission, seconded by Adam Ranslow. All in favor. Dana Dix nominated Brad Lackey as secretary, seconded by Adam Ranslow. All in favor.

Commission discussed the getting work done in certain cemeteries. Dana will search for people/businesses that would be available to cut the “overgrown” section of Green Cemetery and find out costs.

Prices still need to be gathered for wooden fencing along the lower road at the Jacksonville Cemetery. Dana will talk to Wayside Fencing to provide a quote.

Commission discussed that there was another complaint of “high” grass at Cutting Cemetery. Brad will talk with Deerfield Valley Maintenance about cutting more frequently and about whether they had fixed the stonewall along Boyd Cemetery.

Commission discussed that the Avera plot in Jacksonville Cemetery was not marked on the cemetery map and no record of a deed for the sale can be found in the Town Records. Brad will attempt to contact Chris Avera to see if his family has any record of the sale.

Dana Dix made a motion to adjourn at 7:07 p.m., Adam Ranslow seconded. All in favor.
