The Town of Whitingham, an equal opportunity employer, seeks an interested individual to serve as Animal Control Officer.

The Animal Control Officer performs general/specialized work associated with providing effective and efficient animal control and protecting the health and welfare of citizens and animals. It is the Animal Control Officer's duty to enforce the Town of Whitingham Domestic Pet/Animal Control Ordinance.

The Animal Control Officer (ACO) operates under the direction of the Selectboard. The ACO must have the ability to interact with the public with courtesy and professionalism and have the physical strength and agility sufficient to perform tasks that require the ability to exert moderate, though not constant physical effort under various conditions. The ACO must have the ability to interact with the Selectboard by providing verbal and/or written reports in a timely manner about incidents.
