These Minutes will be accepted into the public record (with any corrections noted) at a future meeting of the Whitingham Cemetery Commission.

Dana called meeting to order at 6:37 p.m.

Additions/Deletions: None.

Commission discussed budget items for the next fiscal year. A motion was made by Dana Dix to maintain the same budget figures as the previous fiscal year, seconded by Adam. All in favor.

Commission discussed a comment made by a member of the town that there is a dangerous drop off to the brook along the lower roadway in Jacksonville Cemetery. Commission believes a wooden split rail fence or metal posts with cables would work best there. Dana will try to get prices on the different options.

Commission discussed a natural conservancy easement along the steep bank to the brook at Jacksonville Cemetery that was proposed by the State of Vermont ANR and WRC for a possible flood hazard resiliency project. The commission has no opinion on the matter at this time, but if it is pursued further, much more information is requested.

Commission discussed the recent damage done to the stonewall surrounding Boyd Cemetery. It was decided that it is not necessary to get the stonewall fixed back to its previous condition, but just to pile it back up and clean things up so it doesn't look like a mess. Dana will check with Deerfield Valley Maintenance to see what they would charge.

Dana Dix made a motion to approve the minutes for meetings on April 7, 2021 and July 28, 2021, Adam seconded. All in favor.

Dana Dix made a motion to adjourn at 8:05 p.m., Adam seconded. All in favor.
