If you wish to be heard in a live format in addition to submitting your grievance in writing please provide us with a phone number where we can reach you for a phone grievance. If we are unable to reach you at the time of your appointment at the number you provide, and you do not return our call by the end of grievance hearings, we will decide your grievance based upon the materials provided with your written grievance.*

Please call the town office at 1-802-368-7887 for an appointment. Calls can be made from 9 AM to 2 PM Monday -Friday. You will need to determine if you prefer a Google Hangouts conversation (using Video) or a phone conversation. Grievance request letters and supporting documentation should be mailed to the town office or e-mailed to whitinghamlisters@yahoo.com.

- If you choose a phone conversation you will be called at the specified time. You will need to provide a phone number when the appointment is made.
- If you choose a video conversation you will be sent an email with an invitation for the specified time. You will need a computer with a camera and microphone. You will need to provide an email address when the appointment is made.
